Hope everyone had a great Christmas and has a blessed New Year.

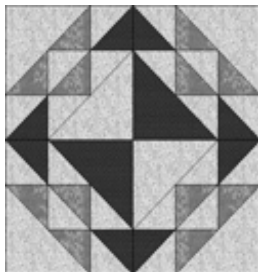
Looks like we are going to have some winter weather.

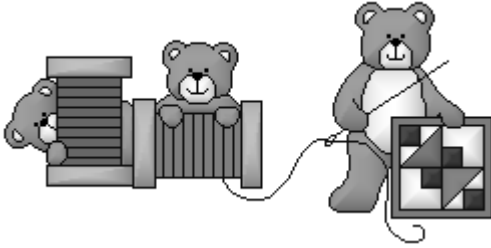
