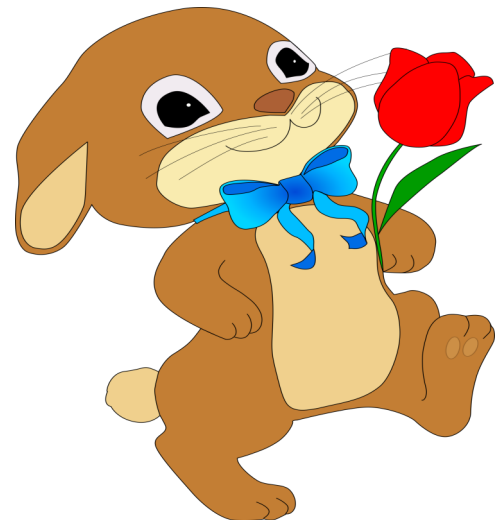
Patty thanked Cheyenne C. for doing the March newsletter. The next newsletter will be done by Karen S. Articles are due by March 29.
