


Melissa's Mini Notes June 2010

Crohn's and Colitis Foundation report from Thomasene

I would like to thank those of you who donated items to the CCFA basket. All baskets will be at the North Side Fire Station. The event will be on Sun., July 11. The walk will begin at the Morgantown North Side Fire Station in Suncrest. It will continue past the WVU Hospital, NIOSH, down past Sheets, past Health South, and back to the North Side Fire Station. It is called *Take Steps for Crohn's and Colitis*. It is an evening walk with registration beginning at 4:30 pm and the walk to begin between 5:30 and 6. Participants will enjoy a casual stroll and raise money for crucial research. Throughout the year, Take Steps enables patients' families to join together with their local community to build visibility and awareness about Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis while raising critical funds.

Over 1.4 million American adults and children are affected by these digestive diseases. While many suffer in silence, Take Steps brings together the community in a fun and energetic atmosphere, encouraging them to make noise and be heard.
