## Country Roads Quilt Guild Minutes September 2012 Meeting

Meeting was called to order by President, Christine. We had six visitors, which included three representatives from Timmy's Fund. Several members were also present.

We started our meeting with a Timmy's Fund presentation, given by Tara, Timmy's mother. The Timmy's Fund quilt, which we will be selling chances for at our Mountaineer Week quilt show this fall, was presented for the membership to view. It was noted that September is childhood cancer month and that this would be a good incentive to work toward promoting cancer awareness and more quilt sales during the month of September.

Minutes and Treasurer's reports were approved as written.

### Old Business:

- 1.) Mountaineer Week Quilt Show – Forms for submitting quilts are on the website and in the newsletter. Terry noted that the web form has auto-fill. Paper forms were also available at this meeting and will be available at the October meeting as well. A sign-up sheet was passed around so that we can determine what quilts are being brought to show. Peggy from the Country Roads Quilt Shop will also put a quilt in the show. A volunteer sheet was passed around as well so that everyone can sign up for a time to work for the show or set up and decorate.
- 2.) Alzheimer's Challenge – The challenge items were shown off. Terry noted that if you do not have a challenge quilt tonight and would still like to participate, there's plenty of time to make one! The Alzheimer's quilts will be displayed at our quilt show and will be mailed off to Ami after the show. Challenge quilt must be able to fill in a 9x11 envelope, and must lay flat.
- 3.) Retreat – Ruth Ann and Donna have information on retreat locations in Kentucky and in Ohio. More information at the next meeting if anyone is interested in going.
- 4.) Workshop – If we want to have a workshop in the month of October, we need to have three people interested in attending. Christine will check to see if the church is available on Saturday, 10/13/12.

### New Business:

- 1.) Quilts at the State Fair – Monica attended the WV State Fair and noted that there were no quilts from our area in the quilt exhibit. She noted that the officials at the show asked for her to return to her guild and please encourage them to submit quilts to the State Fair exhibit.
- 2.) WV State Guild retreat – the WV State Guild retreat is November 9-12<sup>th</sup>, 2012, at Cedar Lakes in Ripley, WV. You must be a WV State Guild member. Membership is \$15 a year. For more information go to their website: [www.wvquilters.org](http://www.wvquilters.org).


